

Every day, more than 800 women and 7,000 babies lose their lives during pregnancy and childbirth - 99 percent are in low- and middle-income countries. The majority of these deaths are preventable if the mother has access to skilled care during pregnancy and childbirth.

The Safe Delivery App provides skilled birth attendants instant, evidence-based and up-to-date clinical guidelines on how to handle complications related to pregnancy and childbirth – straight from their phones or tablets.



Developed with the Universities of Copenhagen and Southern Denmark, the App uses five features: simple, animated instruction videos, procedures, drug lists and an e-learning tool, MyLearning, to guide skilled birth attendants in basic emergency obstetric and newborn care.

In the e-learning component, MyLearning, users can improve and test their knowledge and earn certification as Safe Delivery Champions once completing expert levels in all modules.

All content in the App works offline once downloaded, so healthcare workers in even the most remote settings can always refer to it – either on the job, in their spare time, or as part of their training.

The App is available in global versions in French and English and has been adapted into numerous languages and national clinical guidelines for specific countries.
